MAIN IDEA

Pastor Steve, this Sunday, emphasized the Biblical call to multiply and deepen our faith. He shared vivid examples of disciple-making within our community, celebrating those who are actively engaging in this transformative process. Pastor Steve connected this theme to the broader Biblical narrative, where from Genesis to the words of Jesus, we're encouraged to grow and multiply in our spiritual lives. He also discussed the importance of maintaining our spiritual 'boiling point,' avoiding spiritual complacency, and consistently engaging with our faith to prevent it from cooling off.

TALK IT OUT

- 1. **Reflection on Spiritual Multiplication:** Pastor Steve talked about the joy of seeing spiritual investment grow through disciple-making. Who in your life has been a spiritual multiplier for you, and how can you start to multiply your faith in others? *(Matthew 28:19-20)*
- 2. **Consistency in Faith:** Discuss a time when you felt your spiritual 'boiling point' was high. What practices helped you maintain that heat? How can you reintroduce or strengthen these practices in your daily life to avoid spiritual lukewarmness? (*Revelation 3:15-16*)
- 3. **Overcoming Spiritual Isolation:** Pastor Steve warned about the dangers of isolating ourselves during tough spiritual battles. Share a personal experience where community support helped you overcome a spiritual struggle. How can we better support each other in our walks with Christ? (*Galatians 6:2*)
- 4. **Setting Spiritual Priorities:** Reflecting on the message, what are some worldly distractions that might be cooling your spiritual fervor? How can you actively set your heart on "things above" to combat these influences? (*Colossians 3:1-2*)
